Public meeting on SH-53 improvements in Carter County Jan. 31

Representatives from the Oklahoma Department of Transportation will be in Springer on Tuesday, Jan. 31, to discuss proposed improvement plans for SH-53 in Carter County.

Citizens are asked to attend this informational meeting and give their input on two projects, which will address more than nine miles of SH-53 from about five miles east of the SH-76 junction and extending about nine miles to the east. The projects are estimated at \$35.5 million to reconstruct the pavement and shoulders and to make improvements to eight bridges in this corridor.
