The ODOT Disadvantage Business Enterprise program assists minorityowned and women-owned businesses to become competitive in the highway construction industry. The goal of the conference is to introduce Disadvantage Business Enterprise eligible companies to the procedures for doing business with ODOT as well as give them an overview of ODOT's Disadvantage Business Enterprises program. The Small Business Administration and the Oklahoma Bids Assistance Network will also discuss procedures on how to solicit for contracted services with the federal government.
