WEEKLY UPDATE – Contractor making progress on repairs

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is making progress on the James C. Nance bridge and plans to have it open by the fast approaching June 14 deadline.

The contractor has finished the initial steps in the new repair process that involve removing rivets and replacing them with bolts in preparation to install the repair plates. These areas still need to be sandblasted and painted before plates can be installed.

The arrival of the first repair plates is expected next week, and the contractor is implementing measures to make sure the plates fit correctly since each location is unique.
