Public meeting set to discuss improvement plans for SH-29 east of Marlow in Stephens Co.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is hosting a public meeting to discuss future improvement plans on SH-29 east of Marlow in Stephens Co. Proposed improvements include reconstructing approximately nine miles of SH-29 from near Scott Rd. east of Marlow, to near Morrison Rd. east of Bray, improving safety and sight distance issues, and improving bridge structures.

The purpose of the meeting will be to present project information and to seek comments on the proposal.
