### **January Transportation Commission Meeting**

The Oklahoma Transportation Commission will hold its monthly meeting at 11 a.m. Monday, Jan. 6 in the R.A. Ward Transportation Building, 200 N.E. 21<sup>st</sup> St. in Oklahoma City. Items to be addressed at the meeting include:

- During his report to the commission, Oklahoma Department of Transportation Executive Director Mike Patterson will provide ODOT's reaction to how congress addressed federal transportation bill funding issues.
- The American Concrete Pavement Association will recognize ODOT for its work on the award-winning Oklahoma highway project to rehabilitate the pavement on a six-mile stretch of I-40 in Seminole County.
- The Traffic Engineering Division will announce more than \$5.6 million in safety improvements including cable barrier, signage, striping and rumble strips in various counties around Oklahoma.

The commission, an eight-member panel appointed by the governor to oversee the state's transportation development, awards project contracts for road and bridge construction on a monthly basis.
