November Transportation Commission Meeting

The Oklahoma Transportation Commission will hold its regular monthly meeting at **11 a.m. Monday, Nov. 3** in the R.A. Ward Transportation Building, 200 N.E. 21st St. in Oklahoma City. Items to be addressed at the meeting include:

- Oklahoma Department of Transportation Executive Director Mike Patterson will provide an update on the status of the agency's plan to display real-time traffic information on highway message boards in Oklahoma City and Tulsa.
- The commission is expected to consider whether to award two contracts for major metro area interstate and highway projects including nearly three miles of I-244 pavement and bridge rehabilitation in Tulsa and the next phase of SH-74 widening and interchange construction in Oklahoma City.
- Commissioners are expected to vote on approval of the Federal Fiscal Year 2015-2018 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, which includes projects planned by ODOT, Metropolitan Planning Organizations and other transportation organizations.
- They will also be asked to consider approval of the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges work program for State Fiscal Year 2015-2019.

The commission, an eight-member panel appointed by the governor to oversee the state's transportation development, awards project contracts for road and bridge construction on a monthly basis. The meeting is open to the public.
