AMTRAK 40th ANNIVERSARY EXHIBIT TRAIN IN OKLAHOMA CITY THIS WEEKEND

Model trains, Chuggington Depot, ticket drawings and more on Saturday & Sunday

CHICAGO – The Amtrak Exhibit Train, a unique traveling display showcasing memorabilia from the 40-years of Amtrak railroad history is touring the country and is stopping this weekend at the Amtrak (Santa Fe) station in Oklahoma City.

News media is invited to a preview of the Exhibit Train this Friday afternoon between 1 and 3 p.m. CT.

The Exhibit Train event is free and open to the public 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. CT on Saturday, January 14, and Sunday, January 15. The train will be parked on the Paul Adams Memorial Platform at the station and it showcases Amtrak history over the decades, displaying memorabilia such as vintage advertising, past menus and dinnerware, and period uniforms. Inside the station will be a train-themed kids' activity area, Chuggington Depot, based on the popular television series on Disney Junior and designed for kids ages 2-7 and their families. In addition, commemorative 40th anniversary merchandise will be available for purchase onboard the train.
