Roy Williams – Greater Oklahoma City Chamber President and CEO

Roy Williams became the president and chief executive officer of the Greater Oklahoma City Chamber in Jan. 2004, after having served as executive vice president of economic development since mid-2002. Williams has held numerous executive leadership positions in Chambers of Commerce and Economic Development organizations in Texas, Arizona, Ohio and Oklahoma.



Neal McCaleb – Former Secretary of Transportation & Oklahoma Department of Transportation Executive Director

Neal McCaleb's career as a civil engineer spans more than 60 years. In 1974, McCaleb was elected to the Oklahoma House of Representatives, serving eight years, four as the Republican floor leader. Gov. Henry Bellman appointed him the first Secretary of Transportation in 1987, a position he held until 1991 and again from 1995 to 2001, while also serving as the director of ODOT. He also served as director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority.



David Holt – Mayor of Oklahoma City

In April 2018, David Holt took office as Oklahoma City's 36th mayor. Holt was the youngest mayor of Oklahoma City since 1923 and the first Native American mayor of Oklahoma City. Holt has represented northwest Oklahoma City in the Oklahoma Senate, serving two terms. He also works as director of investor relations at Hall Capital. Holt is focused on continuing Oklahoma City's momentum and working to ensure that it reaches every part of the city.



Tim Gatz – Secretary of Transportation & Oklahoma Department of Transportation Executive Director

In early 2019, Tim Gatz was appointed Secretary of Transportation by Gov. Stitt and the Oklahoma Transportation Commission named him ODOT Executive Director in April 2019. Prior to that appointment, Gatz was the executive director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority since 2016, a position he still retains. He also previously served more than two decades at ODOT in various roles, including Deputy Director.



Kevin Stitt – Governor of Oklahoma

J. Kevin Stitt is the 28th governor of Oklahoma. Stitt is leading the state with a vision to become Top Ten in critical categories from government efficiency to job growth, infrastructure, education and healthcare. Stitt is an entrepreneur and businessman who founded a mortgage company. Stitt is a fourth-generation Oklahoman, raised in Norman.
