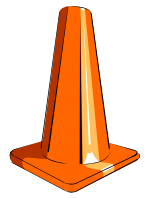


National Work Zone Awareness Week

Oklahoma 2013, 2012, 2011 and National 2012 Statistics

Oklahoma 2013

- 🚧 17 people were killed in Oklahoma highway work zones in 2013.
- 🚧 Also in 2013, 857 people were injured in 1,646 collisions in Oklahoma work zones
- 🚧 This is a nearly 183% increase in fatalities, 130% increase in injuries and a 170% increase in the number of work zones accidents since 2004
- 🚧 The greatest number of collisions resulted from following too close, traveling at unsafe speeds and driver inattention.

Oklahoma 2012

- 🚧 22 people were killed in Oklahoma highway work zones in 2012.
- 🚧 1133 people were injured in 1,971 collisions in Oklahoma work zone.

Oklahoma 2011

- 🚧 20 people were killed in Oklahoma work zones in 2011.
- 🚧 1072 people were injured in 2,036 collisions

Nationwide 2012 (most recent complete statistics)

- 🚧 In 2012, 609 people were killed in highway work zone collisions nationwide
- 🚧 This is up from 2011, when 590 people were killed in work zone collisions.
