











Oklahoma's state parks and recreation areas are among the nation's finest. Most are adjacent to beautiful lakes. Facilities are excellent. Tent camping is free unless in an assigned area. Many state parks have rent-a-tents. RV sites can be reserved by calling the park or recreation area of your choice which maintains assigned areas. Assigned camping for senior citizens, 62 years of age and over, and the totally disabled is one-half the regular price. Accessibility for the handicapped is available at many facilities and there is an on-going program to expand the handicapped facilities.
