At this time, the Department is soliciting the services of consulting engineering and/or architectural companies to provide Preliminary Engineering, Survey, Geotechnical Services, and/or Architectural / Technological services for the preparation of site design plans and architectural building plans for locations identified by the ODOT within limits of the State of Oklahoma as necessary to construct new, technologically advanced Ports of Entry. These services require qualifications, expertise, experience and/or equipment that are of a highly specialized nature. Please find attached a comprehensive list of projects and descriptions for which the Department is seeking the noted services.

The Department's solicitation of interest response mechanism is intended to reduce the reproduction requirements on work of a similar scope that will be reviewed by a common selection committee that is anticipated to include the Corporation Commission. Therefore, your response for the Engineering and/or Architectural Contracts that you are interested in being considered for will include a total of one (1) response packet (one (1) unbound original and five (5) copies) per common selection committee as described as follows:

- A Letter of Interest referencing the Architectural Contract Number (EC No. 1208)
- A Table of Organization depicting the proposed project team
- Any additional information you believe appropriate for the Department's use in determining your capabilities and qualifications to perform the type of work encompassed by that particular contract.
- A statement of your qualifications (CAP 255 Form preferred)

Please remember that this is a SOLICITATION OF INTEREST and not a Request for Proposal. As such, you are only requested to provide information related to your qualifications to perform the work described. Any additional information you choose to provide related to proposed solutions for the solicited projects or any other prepared Contract/Project specific media is NOT required and is unnecessary for the Department's processes. Proposals will be requested upon entering the interview phase of the Consultant Selection Process.

The following factors will be considered primary for determining the firms that will be extended an invitation to interview and/or provide a proposal:

- 1. Experience of the proposed Consultant Team with Department procedures.
- 2. Ability of the Consultant Team to perform the type of work contemplated.
- 3. Specialized qualifications of the Consultant Team applicable to the type of work contemplated.
- 4. Capacity of the Consultant Team to accomplish the work in accordance with the anticipated schedule considering current workloads.
- 5. Past performance of the Consultant Team (references may be requested if not provided).

The deadline for the submittal of your Response Packets will be 4:30 p.m. February 19th, 2008.

The Department anticipates the selection process to be complete and the contracts negotiated and approved by the Transportation Commission as soon as possible and not later than April of 2008. As these contracts are anticipated to be financed with Fiscal Year 2008 State and/or Federal funding, the Notice to Proceed is expected closely following the approval of the Transportation Commission.
