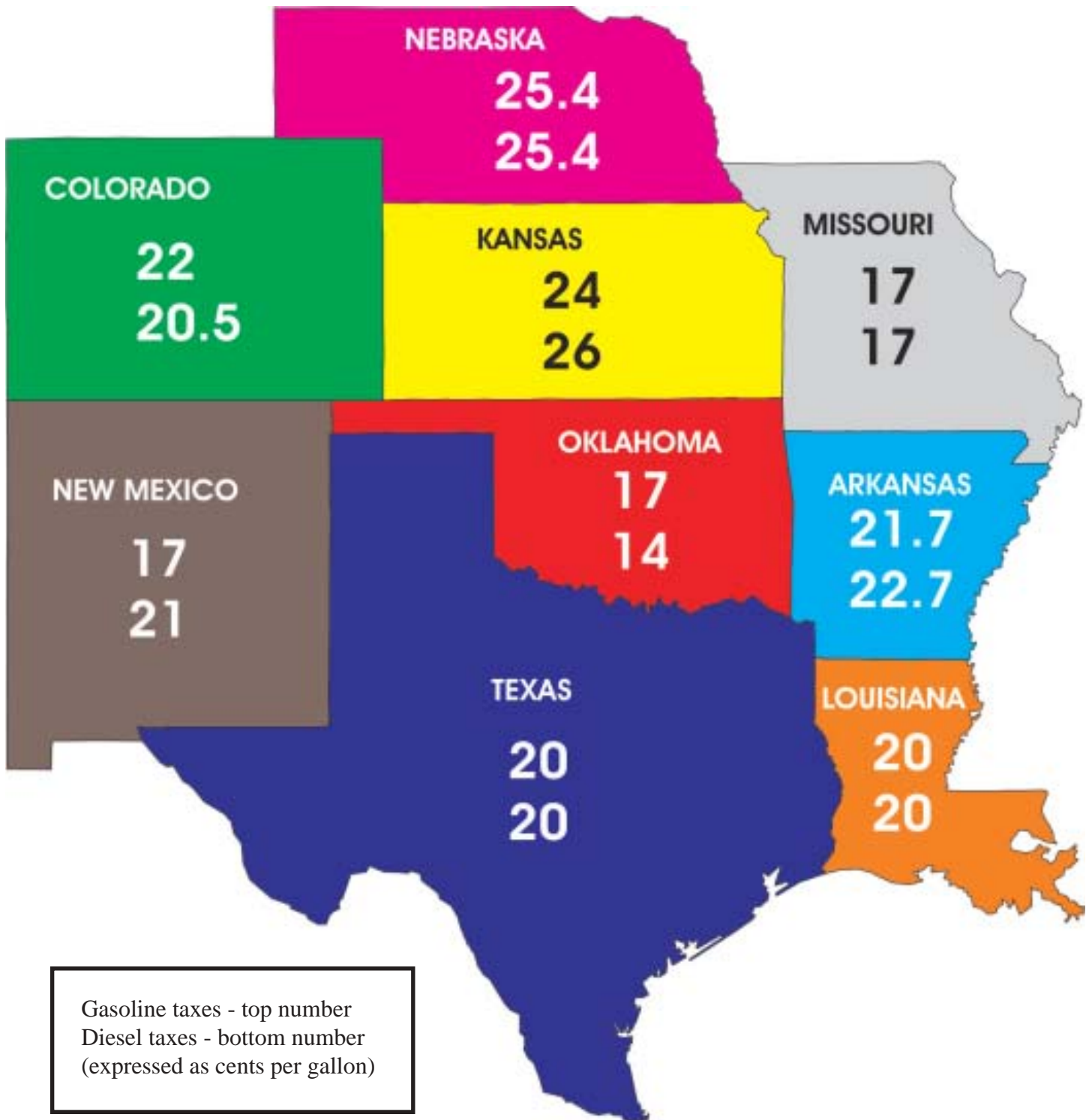


Fuel Tax Comparisions



At the beginning of 2005, Oklahoma's gasoline tax, at 17 cents per gallon, tied with Missouri and New Mexico as the lowest in the region. All other fuel tax rates in the region, both gasoline and diesel, are higher than Oklahoma's. The national average is just under 20 cents per gallon for both. Fuel taxes are the primary resource for transportation money.
