McCorkle Truck / Carbo Ceramics moved our trans load operations to Shawnee, Ok in February 2009, after being in Oklahoma City for 22 years. The reason for the move was that the A-OK Railroad could service our operation faster and more efficient.

Their customer service and overall operation has been outstanding, we have never had to wait for rail service and any issues that have come up about rail service from Oklahoma City to Shawnee has been quickly resolved.

McCorkle Truck Line / Carbo Ceramics has projected a major increase of in trans loading rail cars into tractor trailers for 2009 and 2010.
