# **10.** Supplemental Engineering Contracts

The Transportation Commission previously authorized Triad Design Group to prepare final design plans for the proposed by-pass around the City of Durant on US-70. This supplemental agreement is for additional aerial survey and mapping. Adjusted engineering fees are \$62,.600. Total engineering contract cost, including supplementals, is \$2,287,100. Funding will be 80% federal funds and 20% soft match credit. Projects are currently scheduled in the 8 Year Construction Work Plan with target letting dates in FFY 2006 and FFY 2007, with an estimated improvement value of \$38,000,000.

# ITEM PRESENTED BY THE DIRECTOR - Mr. Ridley

16. Emergency Declaration - Bridge in Leflore County, SH-63 over Pigeon Creek, 6.4 miles east of US-259 Junction

Inspection of the subject bridge on December 20, 2004, revealed moderate to severe damage, resulting in lowering the load posting from 20 tons to 10 tons. Department forces do not have the capability to make these repairs. It is expected that the emergency repair contract will be awarded on Wednesday, January 5, 2005. The estimated cost of the combined stabilization and repair project is \$90,000.
